

BA with Major in Social Science

Required 120 credits (36 of which must be numbered 300 or above, and 30 of which must be from UND) including:

I. Essential Studies Requirements (see University ES listing).

II. At least 45 credits from at least 3 of the following course prefixes: American Indian Studies*, Anthropology, Communication, Criminal Justice, Economics, Geography*, History*, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology. At least 9 credits should be taken in each of the 3 areas. At least 24 credits must be upper division.

Students may also choose to complete an optional subplan for directed study around a theme:

Health and Human Services

- a. At least 18 credits from Psychology
- b. At least 15 credits from Sociology
- c. At least 12 credits from Anthropology and/or Communication

Economic and Political Science Studies

- a. At least 18 credits from Economics
- b. At least 15 credits from Political Science
- c. At least 12 credits from Sociology
