Every degree-granting program offered at UND has identified goals for student learning within the program. Each program with identified learning outcomes has also developed a plan for assessing learning in relation to those goals; assessment activities are carried out yearly and reported in the departmental annual assessment report, as described in the University Assessment Plan.
